ESCC INDIVIDUAL JUNIOR TEAM AWARDS CRITERIA



The individual junior awards are determined by the following criteria:

Team Batting Average

- 1. Must have played the minimum six games for the side
- 2. Have achieved a minimum of 50 runs (30 for rookies)
- 3. The winner will be decided by the following formula. : Batting average taken from MyCricket (home and away only)
- 4. The winner is the player with the best average

Team Bowling Average

- 1. Must have played the minimum six games for the side
- 2. Must have taken a minimum of 5 wickets for the season
- 3. Must have bowled a minimum of 20 overs for U14's and U16's and 15 for U12's (10 for Rookies)
- 4. Best average receives the award

**ESCC AWARD RULES STATE THAT A PLAYER CAN ONLY WIN ONE AWARD. IT IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COACH AND TEAM MANAGER TO MAKE THIS CALL.

Coaches Award

To be awarded at the discretion of the coach to a player that has showed something special for the year .e.g. great team player, best all-rounder, best finals player etc. This can also be taken from MyCricket statistics eg for best fielder or team champion.
