

# ESCC INDIVIDUAL JUNIOR TEAM AWARDS CRITERIA



The individual junior awards are determined by the following criteria:

## Team Batting Average

1. Must have played the minimum six games for the side
2. Have achieved a minimum of 50 runs ( 30 for rookies)
3. The winner will be decided by the following formula. : Batting average – taken from MyCricket (home and away only)
4. The winner is the player with the best average

## Team Bowling Average

1. Must have played the minimum six games for the side
2. Must have taken a minimum of 5 wickets for the season
3. Must have bowled a minimum of 20 overs for U14's and U16's and 15 for U12's (10 for Rookies)
4. Best average receives the award

**\*\*ESCC AWARD RULES STATE THAT A PLAYER CAN ONLY WIN ONE AWARD. IT IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COACH AND TEAM MANAGER TO MAKE THIS CALL.**

## Coaches Award

To be awarded at the discretion of the coach to a player that has showed something special for the year .e.g. great team player, best all-rounder, best finals player etc. This can also be taken from MyCricket statistics eg for best fielder or team champion.

## Junior Club Champion

Based on MyCricket statistic weighted depending on age group and grade

Age Group	Grade and points multiplier				Points Allocation
	A	B	C	D	
18	1	0.8	0.6	0.4	1 point/run 17 points/wicket
16	0.8	0.6	0.4	0.1	10 points/catch
14	0.6	0.4	0.2	0.1	10 points/ RO
12	0.4	0.2	0.1	0.1	10 points/stumping
