REGISTRATION

HOW DO I REGISTER TO PLAY AT ESCC?

Our senior registration and payment process is online at East Sandringham Cricket Club Inc

You will need your mycricket ID to register.

I PLAYED FOR A DIFFERENT CLUB LAST SEASON. CAN I STILL REGISTER WITH ESCC?

If you have played for a different club in the previous three years you should apply to us to transfer/clear your registration to ESCC. You can still register with ESCC however you must be transferred and/or cleared from the club you previously played. We will organise your transfer/clearance and contact you when this process has been finalised.

WHAT IS THE COST OF SENIOR REGISTRATION?

Senior men's registration fees are \$350.00, the same as last season. This includes 2 items of ESCC clothing of your choice (eg Playing Cream Pants, Playing Cream Shirt, Training Shorts, Hoodie etc). We offer a discount of \$100.00 for students and apprentices. Please select this discount option when registering.

Senior women's registration fees are \$200 plus \$5 umpiring fee per game played. You will receive a Playing Top and Playing Shorts as part of your registration.

HOW DOES ESCC'S SUBSCRIPTION FEE COMPARE TO OTHER LOCAL CLUBS AND WHAT DO I GET?

Our subscription fee compares well with other clubs. The fee covers most costs of playing cricket at ESCC including affiliation and insurance.

MUST I REGISTER/PAY TO PLAY?

Yes. All players must be registered to play, and registration can only be completed by paying.

DO I HAVE TO REGISTER ONLINE?

Yes. Registering online is a more efficient way for the club to handle registrations and ensures the club can get live registration updates. Further, it ensures your MyCricket information is up-to-date.

Can I register online but pay separately/manually (direct to club)? No. Online registration can only be completed by paying at the same time.

WHAT FORMS OF PAYMENT CAN I USE FOR ONLINE REGISTRATION?

You can use your debit or credit card to pay online. Payment by credit/debit card is easy and instant.

DO I HAVE TO PAY ADDITIONAL FEES/CHARGES FOR ONLINE REGISTRATION?

No.

IS THE ONLINE REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT PROCESS SECURE?

Yes, both personal data and all payment information are encrypted using SSL (Secure Sockets Layer).

CAN I PAY MY SUBSCRIPTION FEES OVER TIME (PAYMENT PLAN)?

TEAMS

DOES THE CLUB HAVE A WOMEN'S TEAM?

Yes. There is a separate registration product for our women's team. Our first women's team competed in 2020/21 season and we are actively recruiting to grow our women's competition. WHAT IF IT'S MY FIRST TIME PLAYING CRICKET?

We currently have six senior men's teams and one senior women's playing in various grades. We will have a grade to suit you.



CLOTHING

WHAT CLOTHING DO I NEED?

PLAYING

This year, players can elect any TWO items of ESCC cricket clothing of their choice. However, you will need Playing Pants, Playing Shirts and Training Tops – so if you don't already have those, please make sure these form part of your selection.

ONE-DAY PLAYING ATTIRE – LONGMUIR/QUINEY: Players playing Longmuir or Quiney need to have both creams and coloured kit. Please bear this is mind when selecting your clothing choices.

Cricket shoes are also required. ESCC Caps will be available at the club if you don't already have one.

TRAINING

All players need to train in the ESCC training shirt along with dark shorts (navy blue/black) or track pants and runners. If you don't have one, please ensure you select a Training Top as part of your Clothing Selection.

WHERE CAN I PURCHASE CLOTHING?

If you need **additional** clothing to what is provided with your registration, this will need to be purchased online, this will see the same uniforms being worn across the entire club. There is a monthly order cut-off date so please order now. It does take 6 weeks after the cut-off for delivery for orders to arrive at the club, so please bear this in mind when ordering.

WHEN/WHERE IS TRAINING?

PRE-SEASON TRAINING

Pre-season training is expected to commence Sunday, September 5th - Keep an eye on the ESCC website/facebook page/Team APP for a schedule of training dates/times.

SUMMER SEASON TRAINING

Our senior teams generally train together twice a week on Tuesdays and Thursdays at Chisholm Reserve, Duncan Street, Sandringham OR Dane Road, Moorabbin. Keep an eye on the ESCC website/facebook page for a schedule of training dates/times.



GAME DAY

CRICKET ASSOCIATION

All our men's teams will play in the South East Cricket Association (SECA) competition. Women's teams play in the Cricket Southern Bayside Women's Competition.

WHAT DAYS/TIMES DO THE TEAMS PLAY?

Men's senior teams usually play on Saturdays, usually at either 12:30pm or 1pm start time. There will be a combination of one-day and two-day formats (with two-day games being played across two Saturdays).

Women's senior teams usually play on Sundays, at 12:30pm or 1pm start time.

WHEN DO WE GET A FIXTURE?

Season fixtures are available via <u>www.mycricket.com.au</u> as soon as they are finalised by the Associations. Fixtures are subject to change and should be checked ahead of any match.

WHEN DOES THE SEASON START?

IS THERE A BREAK OVER CHRISTMAS?

Yes. The last game before Christmas is usually the second last weekend before Christmas. The first game back after the Christmas break is usually the second or third weekend of January. The fixtures will detail this.
